Saturday in the Park - Outdoor Concert Series Launched at Coffee Creek this Weekend

The inaugural concert of a new outdoor summer concert series featuring the South Shore Brass Band will be held on Saturday, June 25 at 6:00 p.m. Three free community concerts will be held this summer to debut the band at the Coffee Creek Amphitheater in Chesterton, Indiana.
